

FIGHTING CREEK PARK HIKE

MAY 21, 2023 11:00am

Join your RSC friends on a hike in Powhatan, Virginia. The trail is a 2.3-miles out and back. It is considered an easy route and takes about 49 minutes to complete. The scenic trail is well marked with lots of plants.

There are optional trails from which to choose should you want a longer hike. You can take the extension with views of quaint old houses, court buildings, and other historic sites.

Meet in the parking lot (see below for directions) by 11:00. You will receive a trail map upon your arrival.

POST HIKE ACTIVITY:

After the hike you may want to stop by the Three Crosses Distillery. Address: 3835a Old Buckingham Road, Powhatan, VA 23139.

It is approximately a 5-minute drive from the park. If you choose to only meet at the distillery, we will probably meet at approximately 12:30.

Directions to the Parking Lot at Fighting Creek:

Take Route 288 to the US-60/Midlothian Tnpk exit toward Midlothian/Powhatan.

Keep left to continue toward US-60/Midlothian Turnpike. (.7 mi)

- Keep right at the fork and follow signs for U.S. 60/Midlothian Turnpike/Powhatan W. Continue to follow Rt. 60 W for 14 mi.
- Turn left onto State Rte1007/Mann Rd (.6 mi)
- Turn right (50 ft)
- Turn left (50 ft)
- Turn right (0 ft)

You have arrived at Fighting Creek Park (parking lot) – 2201 Mann Rd., Powhatan, VA 23139
